Technology Protection Plan

The Technology Protection Plan (TPP) is highly recommended to all families of students in grades 2-12 as a way to help protect/repair their iPad in case of an accident either at school or at home.

For only \$25 per school year, the device loaned to your student will be covered against all incidental damage or loss over \$50. Accessories (charger and case) and damages valued at less than \$50 are NOT covered and are the sole responsibility of the student. Coverage is 24 hours per day.

NEGLECT/ABUSE IS NOT COVERED. The Technology Protection Plan will only cover two incidents per school year.

If paid, the TPP will release the parent/guardian from having to pay for loss or damage for the following reasons:

• Damages resulting from normal use and accidents.

- Loss or damages resulting from theft. An official copy of a police report is required.
- Loss or damages resulting from a fire. An official fire report from the investigating authority is required.
- Loss or damages resulting from a natural disaster.
- Damages resulting from a power surge.
- Damages resulting from vandalism by another individual. If found guilty, the vandal will be liable to pay for damages.

Without the TPP, your potential out-of-pocket expenses could be as high as \$330.00 per incident!

We strongly encourage you to enroll your student's device in our Technology Protection Plan for the **2023-2024**. Payment is easy and can be paid online by logging into your <u>MyPaymentsPlus</u> account.

For just \$25.00 the TPP will cover 2 incidents with no deductible. Coverage lasts for the entire 2023-2024 school year and is renewable each subsequent school year. The Technology Protection Plan will follow Board Policy-JN.

General School Reminders:

- At this time, we will <u>not</u> be allowing extra students on the bus. Only students assigned to the bus may ride.

- Students are <u>not</u> permitted to get food deliveries from any restaurant or delivery service (Grub Hub, Door Dash, etc.) during their lunch periods. Parents are permitted to drop off lunches for students in the main office.
- WMS has a number of donated backpacks containing school supplies that are available to any student who needs one, while supplies last. Have your student stop by the guidance office to request one.
- Beginning this year, all visitors and volunteers to our school will be required to check in with our new visitor management system. You can <u>click here</u> for more information that was emailed to families.




Weaver PTO Courtyard Project Goal \$10,000

Be Well - Prevention, Awareness, and Recovery Event

District and Community leaders are joining together on September 20 at Darby High School to offer a free event for parents and guardians interested in learning about spotting the signs of substance use addiction.
