This recognition is for schools who had significant improvement in growth and achievement on the Ohio School Report Card. We are proud of the commitment of our students, staff, and Wildcat community. Together, we are creating a positive learning environment where our students are ready to learn, grow, and achieve. We are proud of the hard work taking place at 4600 Avery Road!

Our students and staff have started counting down until the last day of school. We are so close! So far this year, we have seen a drop in the percentage of students missing 10 or more days from 57% to 52%! The number of students who are chronically absent this year is just 39%. We still have work to do, but are grateful for your partnership in making school a priority.

It was great seeing a lot of our Wildcats in action at WMS this week. Best of luck to our student-athletes who are competing this weekend!

General School Reminders:

- As a reminder, all visitors to the school (during the school day) need to report to the main office. We appreciate your support in our commitment to safety.
- For continued safety in the car line, please stay in your lane when picking up your child do not pass any cars in front of you. There are too many vehicles in motion, as well as students walking, and we do not want any unsafe situations.
- Just a reminder that students are permitted to have phones at school, however, they are not to be used during class time. Students are able to use them during their lunch period. Thank you for helping us to reinforce the expectations.

- At this time, we will <u>not</u> be allowing extra students on the bus. Only students assigned to the bus may ride.
- Students are <u>not</u> permitted to get food deliveries from any restaurant or delivery service (Grub Hub, Door Dash, etc.) during their lunch periods. Parents are permitted to drop off lunches for students in the main office.
- If students bring blankets to school, they need to be stored in their locker or in their bookbag. In general, extra layers are encouraged instead of the blankets. This can become a safety hazard as students are walking around desks and could potentially trip on the blanket.

ID Now Required for Visitors Signing Students in or out of School

As part of our ongoing commitment to ensuring the safety and security of our school community, this year Hilliard Schools began using a new visitor check-in system. It has been well received and is both easy to use and enhances the safety of our students, faculty and staff. Beginning this week, School Safe ID will now be required for anyone signing a student in or out of school for any type of early dismissal or appointment.

When signing a student in or out, visitors will be asked to scan their valid state-issued ID at the kiosk located in the high school attendance offices, or the middle and elementary school front offices. This quick process takes less than ten seconds and records only the visitor's name and date of birth. No additional information from the license will be stored in the system.

We understand that this may be a new requirement for some of our families, but we want to reassure you that the safety of our students, faculty, and staff remains our top priority. We appreciate your cooperation and understanding as we implement this important safety measure.
