# STATION: KEY INFORMATION

# A TYPICAL DAY @ STATION...

- **School Day begins at 7:55 and ends at 2:40**
  - *Doors open at 7:45*
  - *Breakfast served @ 7:30; ACE available before/after school*
- **Power Up! to Start the Day**
  - *Similar to Morning Meetings in many elementary schools*
- **8 Periods in the Day**
- **4 Core Classes**
  - **Math, Science, Social Studies, Language Arts (2 period block)**
  - **Grading Policy: Summative, Formative, Practice**
- **2 Periods for Electives/Interventions**
- **Lunch and Recess**

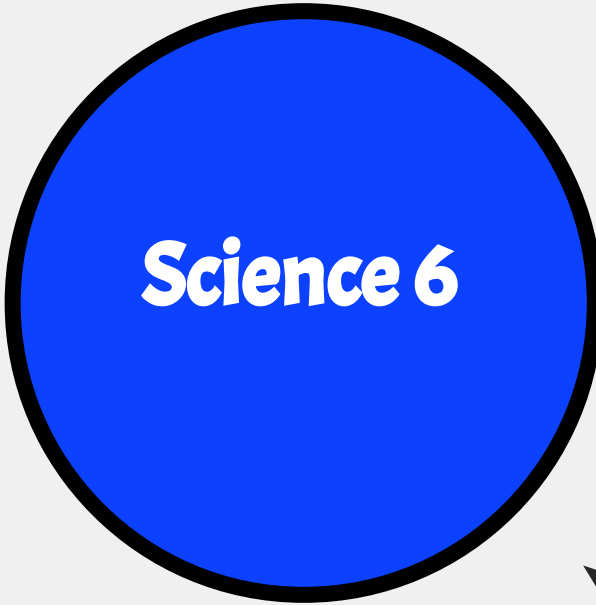

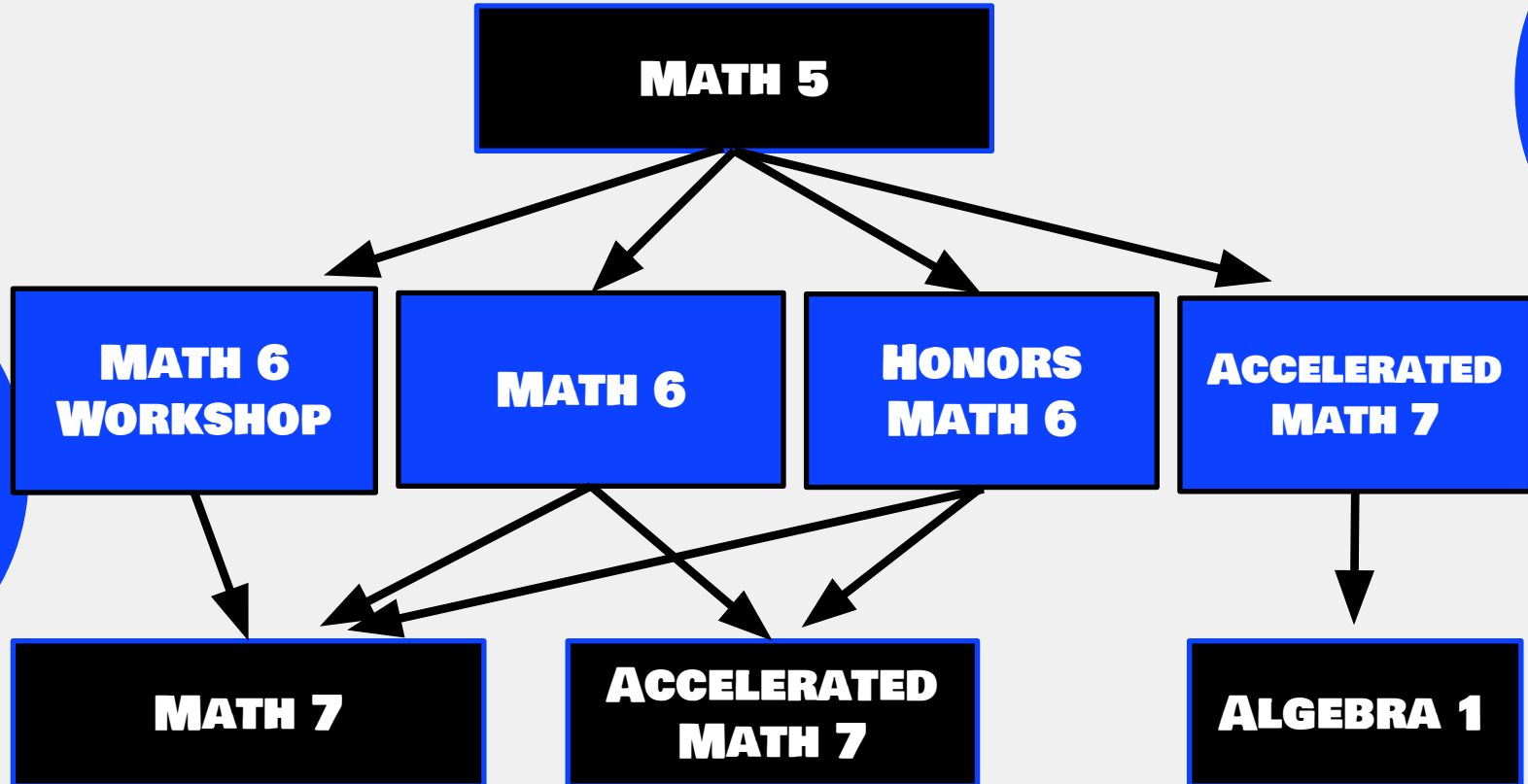

Proper placement is the correct balance between *challenge & enrichment* vs. *frustration & discouragement*



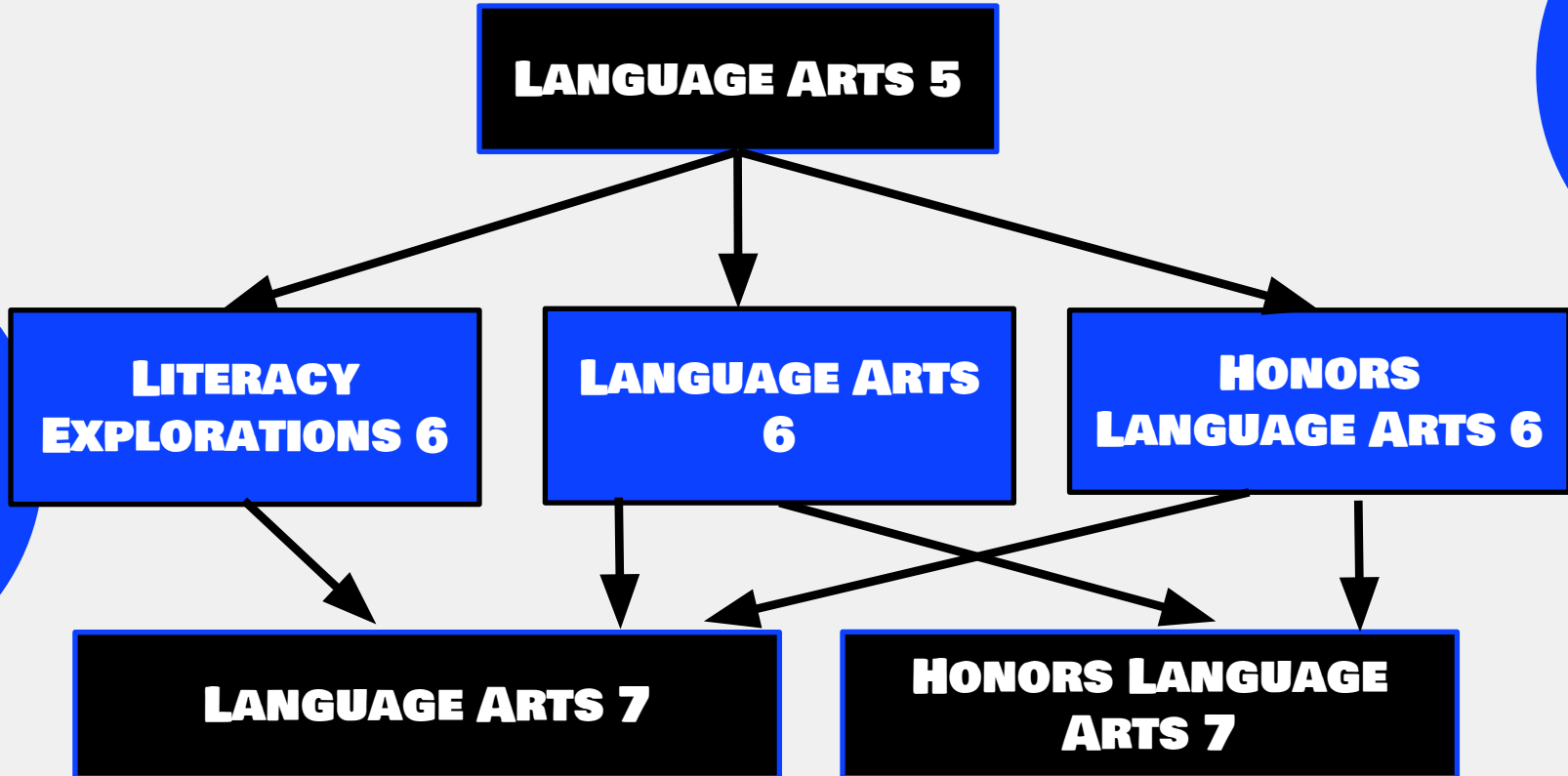
Misplaced students begin to struggle and often become extremely overwhelmed

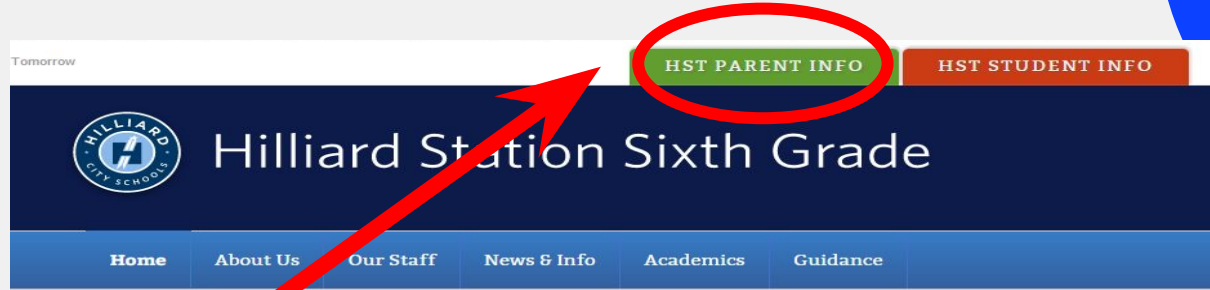
