- 100% of 7th-12th students will have the opportunity to earn 12 industry-recognized credential points and demonstrate proficiency in core subjects as is reflected in a rating of 4 or more stars on the College, Career, Workforce, and Military Readiness component of the state report card.
- 100% of students will meet all state-mandated graduation requirements and receive a high school diploma within four years.
- 100% of students will maintain a satisfactory attendance rate of 95% or better (missing fewer than 10 days per year)






- Maintained 4-Star rating

- Proficiency rates decreased in elementary language arts and 3rd, 4th, and 8th grade math
- Proficiency rates increased in 6th, 7th, and 8th grade language arts, 6th and 7th grade math, Algebra 1, Geometry, ELA II, Biology, US History, and US Government
















### Progress

# **Gap Closing**



- Maintained 5-Star rating
- Met all 9 indicators for Graduation Rate Gap Closing
- Met all 3 targets for Chronic Absenteeism reduction
- Gap Closing with English Learners (0 of 5 possible points)
  and Gifted Students (5 of 15 possible points) requires
  further attention



## Gap Closing

- Graduation Rate
  - Met all 9 of the annual performance goals
- Chronic Absenteeism
  - o 12.8% of students were chronically absent in 2024-2025
  - o *Improvement of 1.1% from 2023-2024*
- English Learners
  - 52.5% of English Learners demonstrated proficiency or met growth target
- Gifted
  - 94% of gifted performance index points
  - Received 47.1% of possible points for gifted identification and services



# **Early Literacy**



- Maintained 3-Star rating
- Overall 70.2%
  - 66.4% Proficient in 3rd Grade Language Arts
  - 99.7% of third graders promoted to fourth grade
  - 34.9% of K-3 students (448 students) moved from off track to on track



### **Graduation Rate**




- Maintained 3-Star rating
  - Weighted Graduation Rate 92.9%
    - Improvement of 1.4% from 2023 cohort
  - 4-Year Graduation Rate (2024 Cohort) 92.7%
  - 5-Year Graduation Rate (2024 Cohort) 93.2%






- New report card component

  - Improvement of 3.5% from 2023 cohort












College, Career, Workforce, & Military Readiness Details - 2024 Cohort
