VolunTeens are teen volunteers that help out at the library during our Summer Reading Challenge. VolunTeens gain valuable skills and experience by assisting customers with signing up for the Summer Reading Challenge, helping with library programs like Reading Buddies, and assisting with other tasks as needed.

Our VolunTeens must provide friendly customer service, be comfortable using a computer, and be willing to try new things. The minimum requirements to be a VolunTeen are:

- Be 12-17 years old. (Must be 12 by June 1, 2024).
- Commit to working a minimum of 15 hours this summer.
- Attend a training session in May.

Application Process:

- 1. Applications open Monday, April 15th at 9 a.m. Applicant space is limited, and applications will close once all spots have been filled. Filling out an application does not guarantee a spot. Applications must be filled out online at http://www.columbuslibrary.org/about/volunteer. Click on the SRC VolunTeen Link to access the application. A valid e-mail address is required. This will be the main way you are contacted.
- 2. All potential applicants will be required to attend a brief interview. The interview dates and times will be emailed to you once the application has been received and processed.
 - After interviews are completed, applicants who are accepted into the program will be given the dates/times of the mandatory training sessions.
