AGREEMENT

The following rules must be followed in order to ride a bicycle to school:

- Wear a helmet to protect the head from injuries. It can be stored in the classroom.
- Ride on the right side of the street.
- Know and obey all Ohio bicycle safety laws.
- Park bike in the bike rack. Bikes cannot be stored anywhere else on school grounds other than the bike racks.
- Use a bike lock. If bike is left unlocked, the school will not be responsible if it is lost or stolen.
- Only 4th and 5th grade students may ride bikes to school independently.
- If younger students choose to ride, they MUST be accompanied by a parent, NOT an older sibling.
- Student riders will walk bicycle through the crosswalk(s).
- Once riders reach the school sidewalk connecting to the bike path, bikes will be walked to the bike rack for the bike to be stored.
- Parents and students understand that the school will not be responsible for damage to the bike while it is on school property.

If the above rules are not followed, the principal will warn the student and parents will be notified. If the rules are not followed for a second time, the student will be suspended from riding his or her bike to school for a 3-day period of time. If rules continue to be an issue after the initial suspension, privileges will be removed for the remainder of the year.
