 - Exploring these interests in High School instead of College can be beneficial

- Tolles services high school students in Dublin, Hilliard, Marysville and Madison County
- Tolles can offer internships Jr and Sr years some internships will pay for college if you continue to work at the facility
- Tolles offers volunteer opportunities with their vehicle repair and cosmetology departments - keep them in mind if you have any car or beauty needs! (For all vehicle repairs, you will still be responsible to pay for parts, but the labor would be free)
- Our 5th graders will be visiting Tolles in May to introduce them to this type of future education
- Tolles has about 400 part time students this year and is looking to increase to 1600 part time students next year!
