State Report Card: Overall Rating for Washington Elementary was 4.5 stars out of 5, exceeding state standards. This grade represents Third - Fifth grade Academic Achievement; Progress, and Gap closing for differentiating student groups.

Question 1): How does the district level wide attendance compare Hilliards?

Answer: Across the board saw improvements. The district report was 12.8% vs. the goal of 20%. The month of May traditionally shows a decline in attendance of the school year. Reinforcing how we can promote being at school. Making sure kids stay connected within their classroom.
